- Shouting: Psalm 100:1; Revelation 9:11-12
- Playing instruments: Psalm 150
- Lifting hands: Lamentations 3:41; Psalm 63:4; Psalm 141:2
- Clapping: Psalm 47:1
- Dancing: 2 Samuel 6:14; Ecclesiastes 3:4
- Standing (with shouts): Revelation 7:9-10

Wholehearted worship
